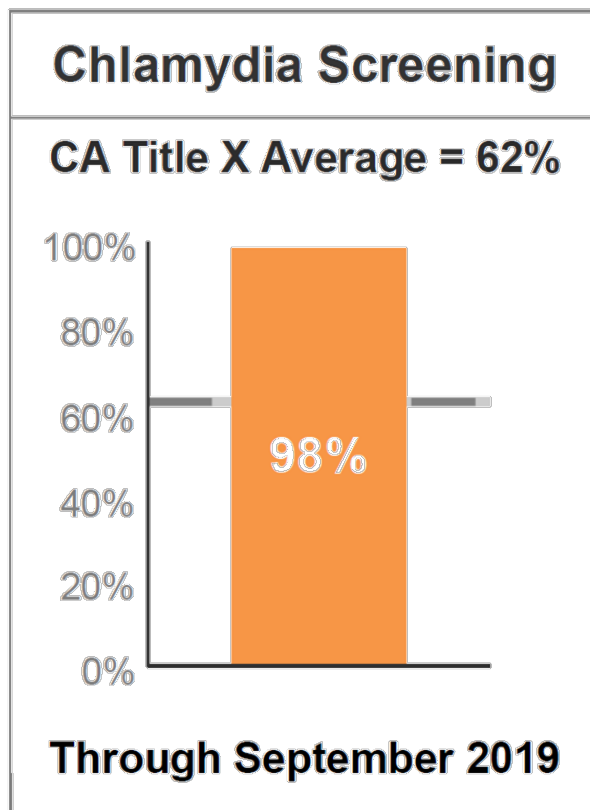

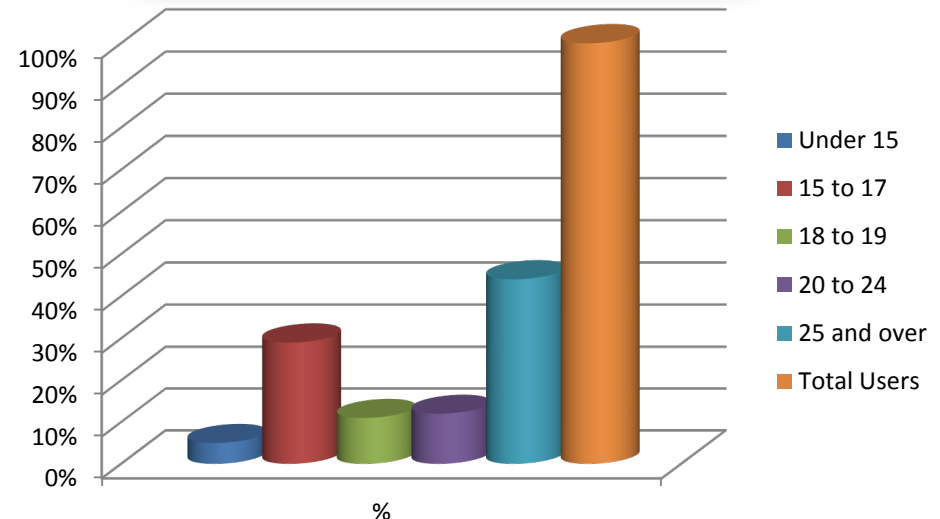
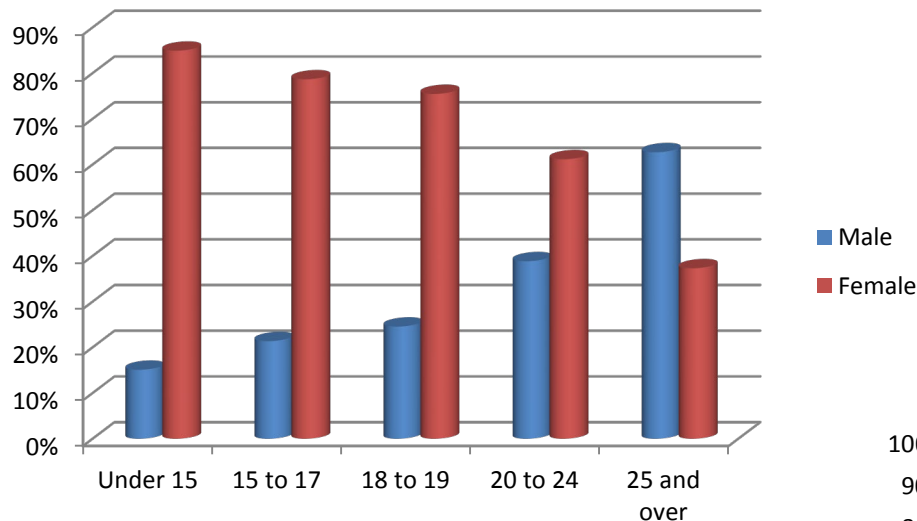


Screening and testing for:

- Every woman < 26 years of age who is starting contraception
- Every woman > 26 years of age who exhibits any risk factor
- All male clients with risk factors or who are sexually active and with more than one partner.



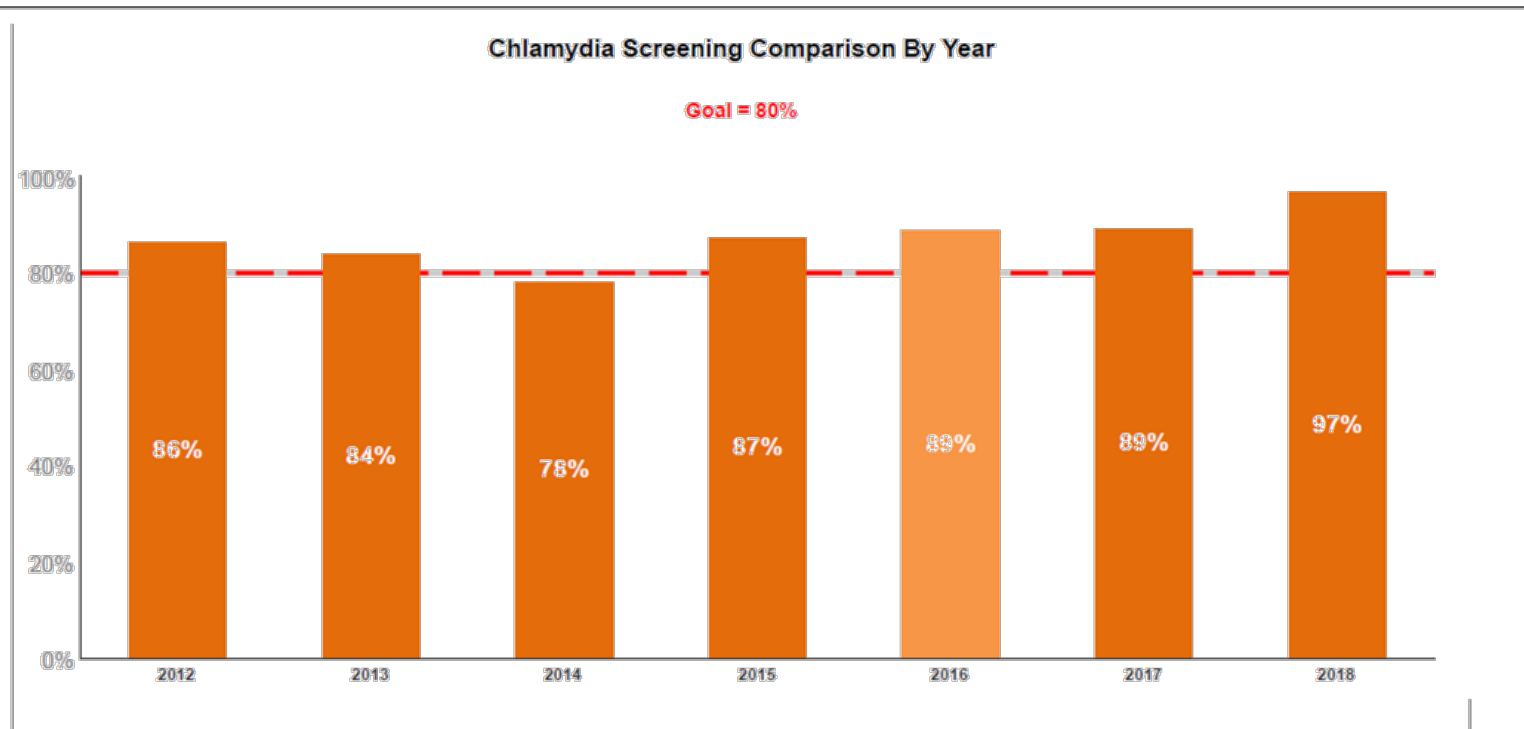
Family Planning Users Tested for Chlamydia by Sex and Age Group

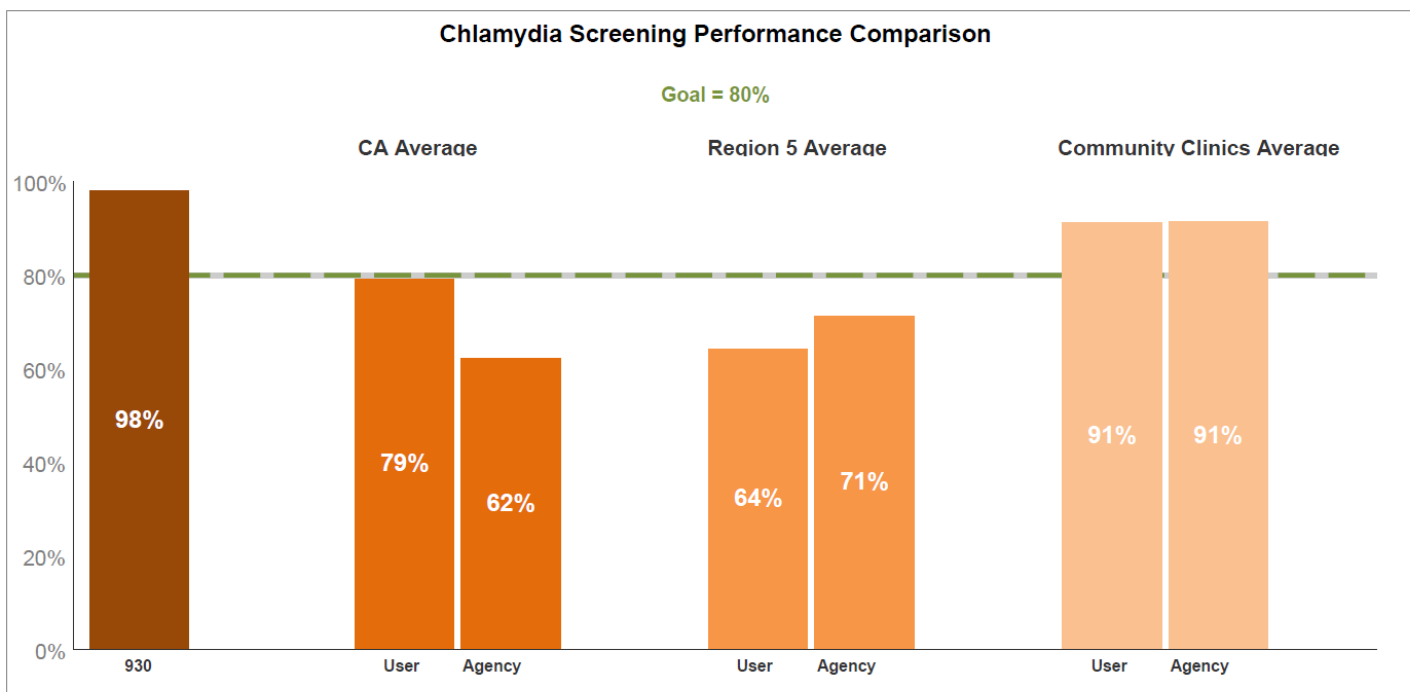

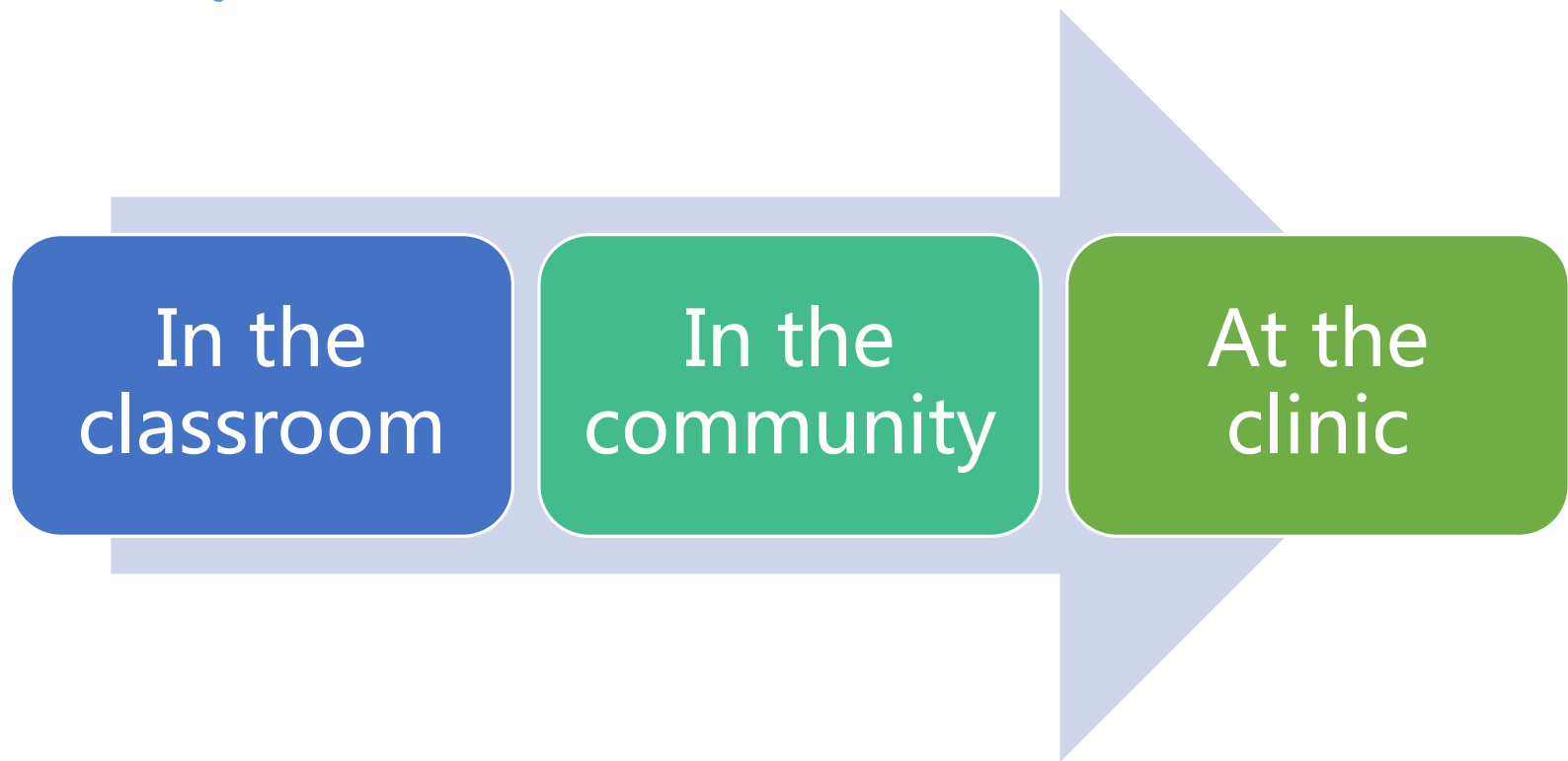

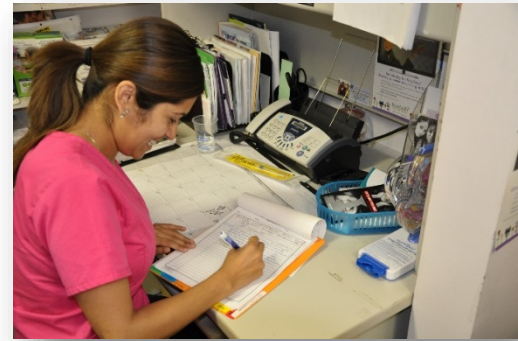

- **Title X Clinic and Family PACT Provider**
 - FDA approved contraceptive methods
 - Emergency contraception pill
 - Pregnancy testing and counseling
 - HIV/AIDS testing
 - STD testing and treatment
 - Education and family planning

Family Planning and Reproductive Health Care Services

- Teen Pregnancy Prevention and Education Counseling
- FDA approved contraceptive methods
- Pregnancy Testing
- HIV/STD Testing and Treatment

Primary Care Services

- Medical Exams
- Physical/Sports and work exams
- Breast, cervical, TB, Hepatitis B and testicular screening

Obstetric services

- Prenatal laboratory work
- Prenatal care up to 35 weeks
- Referral for labor and delivery

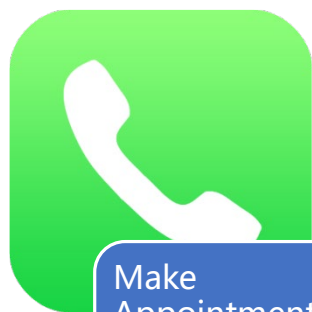

How Does the HEARTT Work



Make Appointment

- Student, Parent, Nurse, Counselor, etc.
- Online option



Pick up from school

- Students check themselves out
- Marked as "Excused Absence" to prevent call



Receive Services

- Family PACT
- Provide water, snacks, cell phone charging station, and safe backpack storage



Return to school

- Pass is given back to class
- Student is checked back into school
