

## TITLE X NATIONAL OVERVIEW



**Every \$1 Invested Saves \$7**

Every \$1 invested in publicly-funded family planning and related services saves taxpayers more than \$7 by helping avert costs related to unintended pregnancies. \$84 million are saved from early treatment and prevention of STDs/HIV, and life-saving cancer screenings at Title X-funded health centers across the country.

### Title X Program Background

Established by Congress in 1970 with broad bi-partisan support, the Title X federal family planning program supports the delivery of high-quality family planning and related services to over 4,000,000 low-income and uninsured individuals nationwide who may otherwise lack access to care.

The Title X program is administered by the Office of Population Affairs (OPA) within the Department of Health and Human Services.

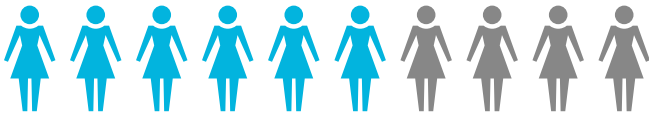
### Title X Family Planning Services

Title X funded services include:

- Contraceptive care
- STD + HIV prevention education, counseling, testing + treatment
- Adolescent services
- Infertility services
- Pregnancy testing + options counseling

Funds may also be used for outreach and education efforts that link community members to care.

**Title X funding may not be used to provide abortion services.**

## TITLE X IN CALIFORNIA



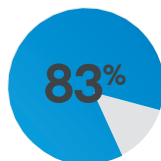
### California's Title X Provider Network: Fast Facts

Essential Access Health administers the Title X program in California—the largest Title X system in the country. Our Title X network includes comprehensive family planning service providers, STD prevention partners, and faith and community based outreach and education partners. Prior to the Title X regulations introduced by the Trump-Pence administration in 2018, the program served over 1,000,000 patients in CA across 38 counties. As of early 2020:

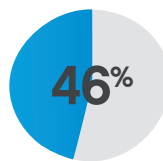
- **251** health centers deliver Title X services
- **51** health care agencies receive Title X funding
- **11** faith + community based outreach + education partners receive Title X funding
- **3** STD prevention partners receive Title X funding
- **23** of California's 58 counties have a Title X-funded service site or organization

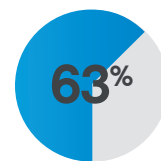
**2019 Title X Patients in California**
